



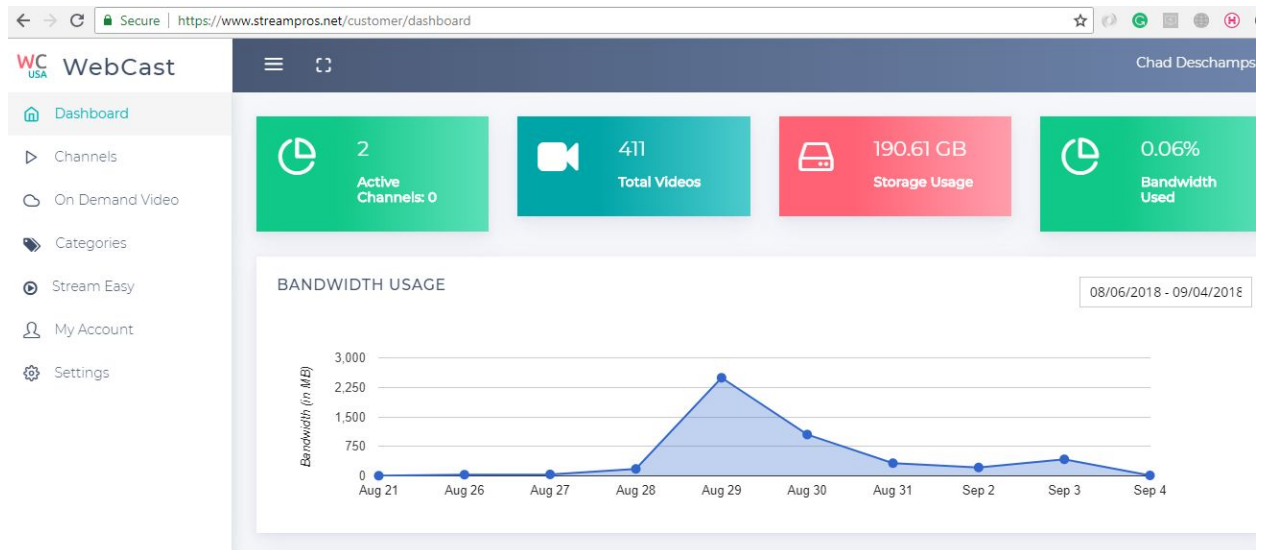

2.3 Dashboard

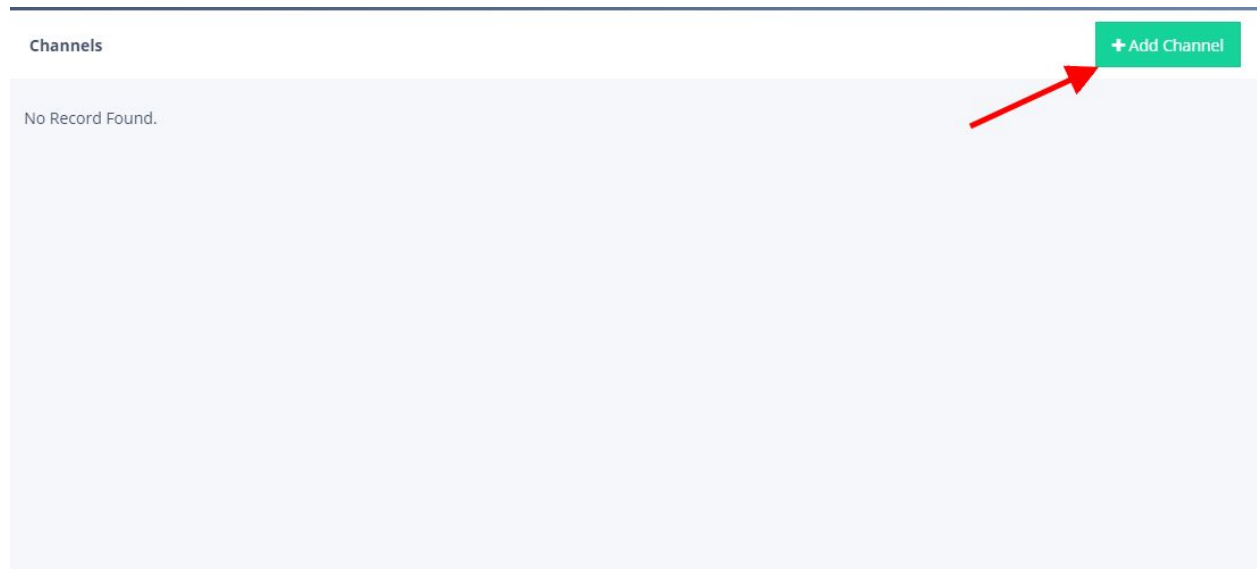

For publishing RTMP stream, copy the URL into your encoder and enter stream name in it.

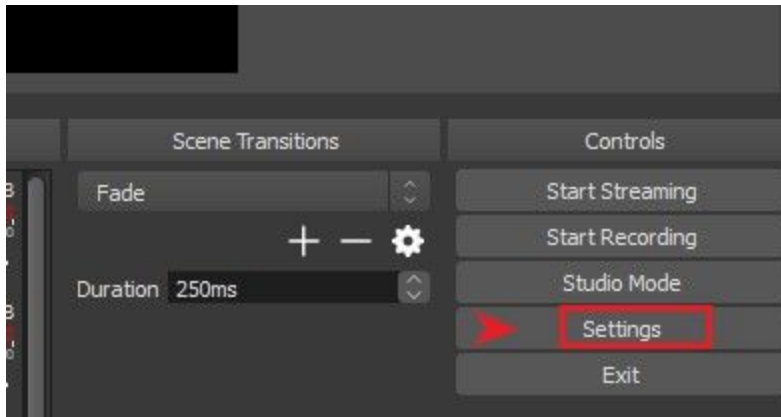
For IPCamera stream, click on Pull from existing video stream button.

You can simply copy your channel embed code and paste into another website.

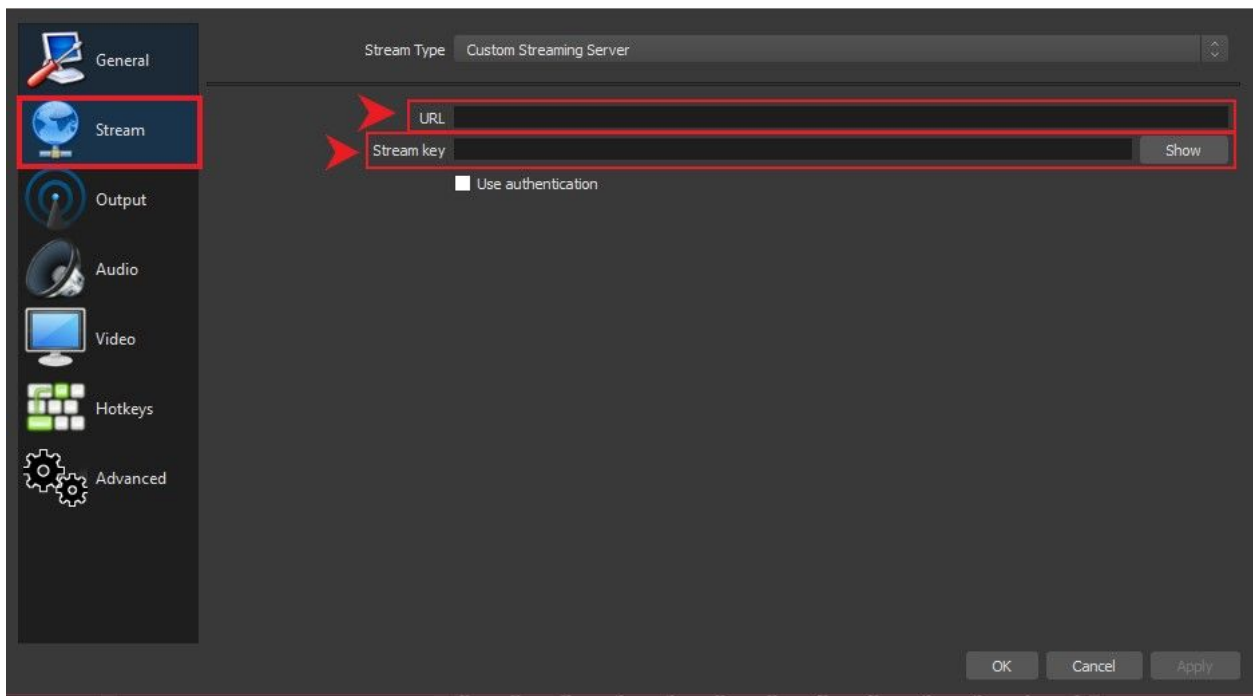
Click on the Save button to create your channel.

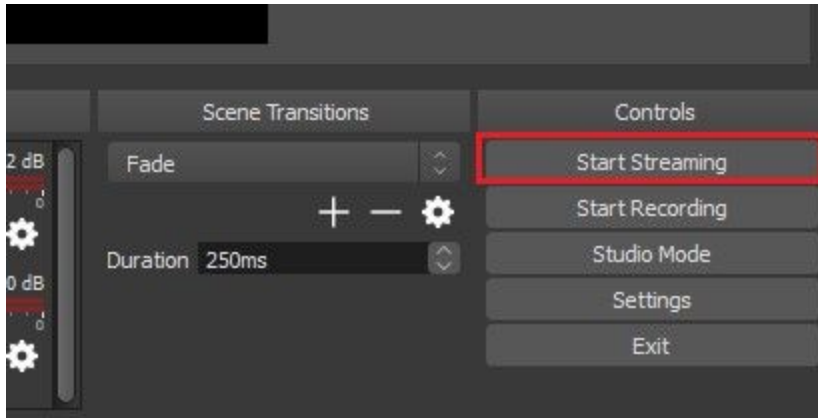
For Publishing RTMP stream, for example click on the setting button in the OBS software as shown in the below image.



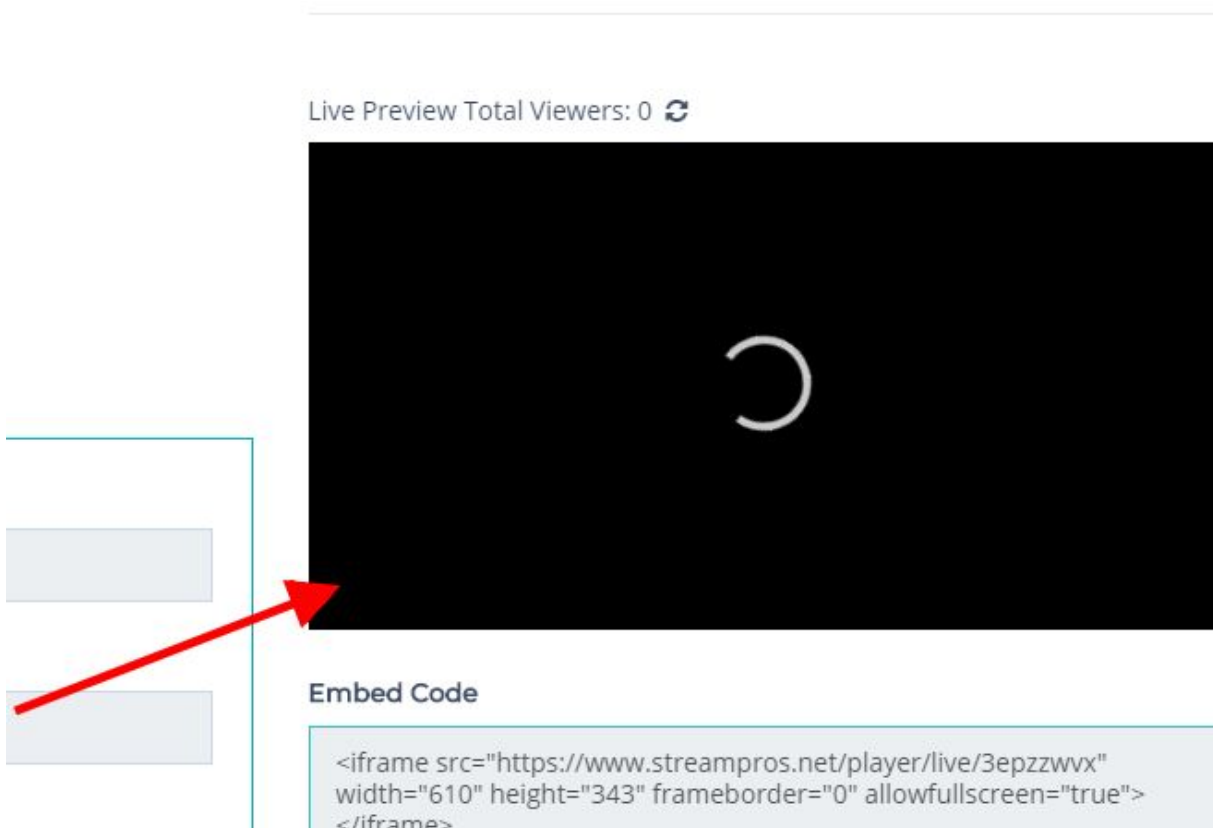
Enter RTMP stream URL and Stream Key in these fields and click on the OK button as shown in the screenshot.

You can search your video by entering the video title in the search field.


